3. Description of the training offered:

This training is meant to prepare individuals to earn a CDL-A or CDL-B. A 12-hour training is offered to prepare students to earn the CDL-B Learner's Permit. Students can then transition into the CDL-B training course which totals 90 hours and blends hands-on and classroom training. A 300-hour CDL-A training is offered in partnership with Hagerstown Community College.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

Students are prepared to test for:

- CDL-A
- CDL-B

5. Am I eligible?

To be eligible for this training program, applicants must:

- Be unemployed or underemployed
- Reside in Montgomery, Frederick, Howard, Prince George's or Baltimore counties
- Be free of any DUI/DWI and have less than 2 points on driving record

- Have at least 3 years of non-provisional driving experience
- Be able to pass the drug & alcohol screen required for CDL training
- Be able to pass any criminal background check
- Be willing to share employment data upon successful completion of program

6. What is the application process?

7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment in the transportation and logistics field?

Trainees who complete the CDL-A program and obtain employment can expect to earn an average of \$26 per hour.

Trainees who complete the CDL-B program and obtain employment can expect to earn an average of \$14-\$20 per hour.

8: How much do I have to pay for this program?

Students can expect to pay about \$85.00 for this program.
