Implementation of the Nondiscrimination and Equal Opportunity Provisions

PURPOSE:

To provide guidance to local workforce investment areas regarding State monitoring of the comprehensive One Stop Career Centers and the programmatic monitoring of the Workforce Investment Act programs.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Workforce Investment Act (WIA) mandates the necessity to monitor recipients and subrecipients of grants awarded under WIA Title 1B to determine compliance with the Act and WIA regulations. The Division of Workforce Development and Adult Learning (DWDAL) Office of Workforce Development (OWD) has developed a monitoring system to assess WIA programmatic activities and the One Stop delivery system in the local workforce investment area (LWIA) for compliance with applicable laws and regulations. On an annual basis OWD staff will conduct LWIA monitoring based on process and procedures in the One Stop Career Center and Programmatic Monitoring Guide and Questionnaires included in this field instruction. Monitoring components within the purview of OWD may include Equal Opportunity and Nondiscrimination, National Emergency Grants, and Statewide On-the-Job Training which allows for flexibility in monitoring as required.

The monitoring will consist of:

- Determining compliance with federal, state, and local area guidance regarding WIA implementation;
- Determining data in participant case files is accurate, reliable, up-to-date, and compliant;
- Providing technical assistance as needed and when appropriate;
- Developing monitoring reports, requesting corrective action and conducting follow up.

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## ACTION TO E TAKEN:

Local Workforce Investment Areas should be aware of the States' process for monitoring using the One Stop Career Center and Programmatic guidelines provided in this field instruction.
