This Instruction implements the inspection policy and procedures necessary for uniform enforcement for OSHA's steel erection standard by field personnel. While MOSH did not originally adopt the OSHA Instruction, it was used to provide guidance to field personnel.

- 2. Compliance and Consultation Supervisors shall ensure that field personnel are familiar with the contents of this Instruction.
