3. Description of the training offered:

This training is meant to prepare individuals to earn a CDL-A or CDL-B license. CDL-A training is 120 hours and includes both classroom and hands-on training. CDL-B training is one week and includes classroom and hands-on training.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

- CDL-A license
- CDL-B license with Passenger Endorsement

5. Am I eligible?

To be eligible for this training program, applicants must:

- Be 18 or older
- Be able to pass a drug test
- Less than 3 points on driving record
- Be residents of Anne Arundel County

6. What is the application process?

7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment in the transportation field?

Trainees who complete this program, earn a CDL-A license, and obtain employment can expect to earn an average of \$25 per hour.

Trainees who complete this program, earn a CDL-B license, and obtain employment can expect to earn an average of \$22 per hour.

8: How much do I have to pay for this program?

There is no cost to trainees.
