Public Law 112-10, Division B, Title I, Section 1101, 1104, and 1119, and Section 1801 of Title VIII, signed April 15, 2011, Department of Labor Appropriations Act, 2010, P.L. 111-117, Division D, Title I, Training and Employment Guidance Letter 23-10, Workforce Investment Act of 1998, (29 U.S. Code 2801 et seq, Public Law 105-220, as amended, Wagner-Peyser Act, as amended (29 U.S. Code 49 et seq, WIA Final Rule, 20 Code of Federal Regulations parts 660-671, Planning Guidance for the Strategic State Plan for Title I of the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 and the Wagner-Peyser Act

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Workforce Investment Act (WIA) requires that Local Workforce Investment Boards submit a five-year strategic plan to the State Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulations. The current planning cycle ends June 30, 2011. PY2011 will be covered under an extension request submitted to DLLR (see WIFI 06-10) Please note the following:

- PY 2011 Youth funding is available effective April 1, 2011
- PY 2011 calculations are based on 5% Statewide Set-Aside funds
- FY 2012 calculations are based on 15% Statewide Set-Aside funds
- DOL will issue a final determination regarding the FY 2012 Statewide Set-Aside funds
- If the final determination changes the FY 2012 Statewide Set-Aside funds to 5%, DLLR will make the appropriate changes to your allocations

Your PY 2011 and FY 2012 allocations are attached. Up to 10% of the allocation can be used for administrative expenditures.
