CALL TO ORDER

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion (I) was made by Captain Paul Caubo, seconded by Bill Smith and unanimously carried by the Board to approve the Minutes of the June 12, 2020 meeting, without correction.

INCIDENT COMMITTEE REPORT

There are currently no incidents.

PILOT COMPLEMENT REPORT

Captain Nielsen reported the following:

Arrivals – Down 18% YTD.

Cargo – No Change

Retiring Pilots – All planned retirements have been completed for 2020. Currently projecting six retirements in 2021. The Association will continue to monitor for any changes.

Proposed Pilot Complement – The Association of Maryland Pilots recommended two new pilots in training (PIT) to start on February 1, 2021.

WORK RULES COMMITTEE REPORT

The Work Rules Committee presented a proposal to allow limited licensed pilots (LLPs) to perform docking of ships, if they choose to do so. It was noted that LLPs are currently able to undock ships. The Committee recommended approval of the work rule proposal by the Board.

Motion (II) was made by Captain Paul Swensen, seconded by Captain Bill Smith and unanimously carried by the Board to approve the work rule allowing LLPs to perform docking of ships.

PILOT-IN-TRAINING (PIT) SELECTION COMMITTEE REPORT

The selection committee recommended extending the 2020 PIT application period by one year. Pursuant to the recommendation, the Board will hold all submitted applications and continue to accept new applications through December 31, 2021. This change is being recommended to ensure the process remains fair during the COVID Pandemic. Board counsel, Milena Trust, confirmed that the Board has the authority to extend the applications pursuant to the applicable regulations.

Motion (III) was made by Captain Paul Caubo, seconded by Captain Bill Smith and unanimously carried by the Board to approve the PIT application extension.

The committee recommended that a notification be sent out to existing candidates to advise them of extension.

QUALIFICATION COMMITTEE REPORT

The Qualifications Committee recommended the following four pilots for licensing upgrade:
