Executive Director's Report

However, the Maryland Society of Engineers did put forth a new law that requires all applicants to pass the Fundamentals of Engineering exam as well as the Principles and Practice of Engineering exam to achieve licensure in Maryland.

Ms. Fielder stated that the board members and administrative staff must monitor the Council of Landscape Architectural Registration Boards and American Society of Landscape Architects websites to ensure the information matches what is on the Department of Labor website.

Ms. Fielder also encourage this board to explore opportunities to recognize newly licensed landscape architects in Maryland during scheduled events of the local chapter of the American Society of Landscape Architects (ASLA).

Regulatory Committee Report for Statute and Regulation Review

Ms. English reported that she and Ms. Fielder completed their review of the statutes and regulations, and will be working with Mr. Thomas and Mr. Venuti on how to approach modifying and updating the laws.

Emeritus Status

Ms. Fielder inquires to the next steps to ensure the next steps to keep legislation for the emeritus status on track. Mr. Venuti responded that an informal draft of legislation could be presented to the Office of the Secretary by this upcoming fall.
