CONSENT ORDER

This matter comes before the State Board of Architects (the "Board") as the result of an audit of the Continuing Professional Competency ("CPC") requirements conducted by the Board in connection with the 2016 renewal application of Charles J. Reagan ("Respondent") license no. 04-14052. As a result of the audit, it was determined that the Respondent did not complete the required hours of continuing education for renewal of his license. In order to resolve this matter, the Board and the Respondent have agreed to enter into this Consent Order, and agree and stipulate to the following:

- 1. The Respondent's license to practice architecture expired on December 27, 2016.
- The Respondent submitted an application to renew his license on November 11,
 2016.
- 3. Pursuant to Section 3-309.1, Business Occupations and Professions
 Article, Maryland Annotated Code and Section 09.21.05 of the Code of Maryland
 Regulations (COMAR), the Respondent was required to complete 24 hours of continuing
 education during the 24 month period preceding the renewal date of November 11, 2016.
- 4. The Respondent certified on his application that the CPC requirement had been fulfilled before submitting his application for renewal.

- 5. On November 11, 2016, the Respondent was notified that he was the subject of an audit of his CPC hours and was required to provide certificates of completion or a transcript of the hours to the Board within 30 days of the date of the audit.
- 6. The Respondent failed to respond to the audit or provide any evidence of completing the CPC requirement until February 8, 2017 when the Respondent provided evidence of completing 22 of the required 24 hours of continuing education.
- 7. The Respondent acknowledges that failure to obtain all the required CPC hours before submitting his application for renewal is a violation of Section 309.1 of the Business Occupations and Professions Article, Maryland Annotated Code, and COMAR 09.21.05.
- 8. The Respondent agrees to pay a fine in the amount of two hundred dollars (\$200) for failing to complete the CPC requirements before submitting his application for renewal.
- 9. The Respondent agrees to pay the fine with acceptance of this Consent Order.
- 10. The Respondent agrees to complete 2 hours of continuing education in health, safety, and welfare (HSW) subjects acceptable to the Board within 30 days of this Consent Order.
- 11. The Respondent agrees to provide to the Board the original certificates or transcripts showing completion of 2 hours of continuing education within 30 days of acceptance of this Consent Order.
- 12. The Respondent waives the right to the issuance of a statement of charges and a formal hearing on the charges in this matter and where the Respondent would have the opportunity to present a defense to the charges.

- 13. The Respondent agrees that if the Respondent fails to comply with the terms of this Consent Order, the Respondent's license will immediately be suspended by the Board, without a hearing on the suspension, and that the suspension will continue until the Respondent evidences compliance with the Consent Order. The Respondent recognizes that should the license be suspended, the Board is required to notify the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards (NCARB) of the suspension.
- 14. The Respondent and the Board understand that this Consent Order will serve as the Final Order in this matter and be a part of the Respondent's licensing record that is maintained by the Board. The Board's records and publications will reflect the terms of the Consent Order.

- I. That the Respondent has violated Section 3-309.1 of the Business Occupations and Professions Article, Maryland Annotated Code and COMAR 09.21.05 for failing to meet the minimum requirements of CPC before submitting his application for renewal;
- II. That the Respondent shall pay a fine of two hundred dollars (\$200) in connection with the violation upon acceptance of this Consent Order;
- III. That the Respondent shall complete 2 hours of continuing education in HSW subjects acceptable to the Board and provide to the Board original certificates or transcripts verifying completion of the continuing education within thirty (30) days of the acceptance of this Consent Order;

IV. That in the event the terms and conditions of this Consent Order are not met by the Respondent, the Board shall immediately suspend the Respondent's license, without a hearing on the suspension, and that the suspension will continue until such time as the Respondent evidences compliance with the terms of this Consent Order, and NCARB shall be notified of the suspension; and,

V. That the records of the Board shall reflect that this matter was resolved with this Consent Order.
