Mr. Finneran informed the Commission that the lack of citations is due to the lengthy process.

Comments from the Chair

Mr. Tunney thanked Mr. Altieri for filling in for Mr. Quackenbush in today's hearings. Mr. Finneran said that everyone has been doing a great job.

Comments from the Executive Director

Mr. Finneran informed the Commissioners that MHIC Complaint Secretary, Tenaea Thomas has been informed that the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) will not be accepting any more hearing requests until after April 1, 2020 due to a large case load.

Mr. Finneran informed the Commissioners that Senate Bill 116 has been proposed in the 2020 legislative session. SB 116 is the Maryland Home Improvement Commission Sunset Extension allowing MHIC to continue to have funding through the year 2032. Mr. Finneran expects this Bill to move forward.

Mr. Finneran informed the Commissioners of House Bill 770 which is an Act concerning Business Regulation-Home Improvement Contracts-Deposits. This Bill proposes to increase initial home improvement contract deposit limits from 1/3 of contract price to ½ of contract price.

Mr. Finneran informed the Commissioners of House Bill 776 which is an Act concerning Home Builders and Home Improvement Contractors, Contract Requirements, Consumer Protection Information. Ms. White feels that this House Bill was drafted because home improvement contractors do not write contracts in accordance with the law. She feels that this injures the Consumer and the Contractor should be educated on how to write a contract.

Mr. Finneran informed the Commissioners that Binita Sharma, MHIC Secretary to the Investigators has taken a new position with a local hospital. Her last day with the Commission was January 31, 2020. The open position will be posted very soon.

Mr. Finneran informed the Commissioners that there is currently a position for Licensing Clerk that is being filled by a temp. This open position will be posted soon.

Mr. Finneran informed the Commissioners that the Maryland Home and Garden Show in Timonium will start on February 29, 2020 and run through March 8, 2020. MHIC will staff a booth during the show.

Mr. Finneran informed the Commissioners that he and Ms. Deborah Irvin-Cromwell will have a booth at the Government Agency Expo held at the Department of General Services (DGS) in Baltimore on February 19, 2020.

Mr. Hart informed the Commissioners that he will be leaving as Assistant Attorney General Advice Counsel for the MHIC. The new Assistant Attorney General Advice Counsel will start on February 26, 2020. Mr. Hart will help with training and also he will be at the next Commission meeting with the new Assistant Attorney General. Mr. Hart thanked Mr. Finneran, Ms. Irvin-Cromwell and Ms. Thomas for everything.
