### **CPC COMMITTEE REPORT**

Motion (V) was made by Mr. Mongan, seconded by Ms. Perrin, and unanimously carried to approve the CPC Provider applications of Contech Engineered Solutions, LLC and Cummins-Wagner Co., Inc.

## REPORT FROM EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Ms. Edwards introduced the new office secretary, Linda Washington, to the Board. Ms. Edwards informed the Board that the position for Board secretary for the Land Surveyors/ Landscape Architects Board has been advertised and the cut- off date to submit an application is June 16, 2015. She also mentioned that a request for freeze exemption has been submitted for the position of Secretary for the Board of Certified Interior Designers and we are waiting for approval.

Ms. Edwards informed the Board that she had submitted out of state travel requests for Mr. Farinas, Mr. Mongan and Mr. Baseman to attend the NCEES Annual meeting. The Board asked that she also submit a request for Ms. Murphy. She also suggested the Board members bring in their electronic devices for the Board meetings and she will supply them with the wi-fi connections so that they can access meeting materials during the board meeting.

### REPORT FROM BOARD COUNSEL

Ms. Trust reported that the Surveyors Board has put together a task force to look into the possible revision of their continuing professional competency regulations. Licensees are experiencing difficulty with their outcome measures. She also mentioned they are in the process of re-writing their education bill to require education and passage of the Fundamentals of Surveying examination as of 2025. Ms. Trust also reported that CPC regulations have not been approved for the Landscape Architects Board.

Chairman Harclerode asked that Ms. Edwards check on NCEES' basecamp to see what other states have a work experience only option for licensing. He also stated that Ms. Courtney has been keeping an ongoing record of how many applicants apply for the Principles and Practice of Engineering (PE) examination under the work experience option and how many had engineering degrees. Chairman Harclerode asked that Ms. Courtney be prepared with those statistics to include how many applicants were out of state residents and how many passed the PE exam.

# Status of Firm Permit Fee Regulations

Ms. Edwards stated that there was no new information to report regarding the status of firm permit fees regulations. The Board discussed possible alternatives if fees are not in place by October 1, 2015. They agreed to delay a decision until the next Board meeting.

# **Financial Update**

Mr. James Kidd supplied the Board with a financial update to include revenues and expenditures for the Design Boards and a breakdown of revenues by each Board. As of April 30, 2015, the report showed the Design Boards with a balance of \$146,000.

## **CORRESPONDENCE**

## Letter from Danish Verma regarding Licensing Requirements

The Board received a letter from Danish Verma questioning the licensing requirements to become a professional engineer in the State of MD. Specifically, he was concerned about how an electrician can qualify to take the PE exam. The Board pointed out that all applicants must submit evidence of engineering work experience that is satisfactory to the Board and indicates to the Board that the applicant may be competent to practice engineering. Ms. Edwards will respond to his letter.

# Email from Ben Fabina regarding obtaining Licensure by Reciprocity

The Board received an email from Ben Fabina dated June 2, 2015 questioning his eligibility to apply for PE licensure by reciprocity. Mr. Fabina applied for the Fundamentals of Engineering examination in 2008 and was denied by the Board because he did not meet the criteria of the Engineering Curriculum Checklist. Specifically, he lacked credit hours in Mathematics and Basic Sciences. Since being denied, Mr. Fabina took courses at Montgomery College and Howard Community College so he could meet the criteria of the Engineering Checklist and would like to apply for PE licensure in Maryland by Reciprocity. Chairman Harclerode reviewed the Checklist that he submitted along with his NCEES Council Record and found that he now met the criteria of the Checklist and can apply for reciprocity with four years of engineering work experience. Chairman Harclerode based his decision on the policy adopted by the Board at the April 9, 2015 meeting for distinguishing four-year engineering degrees in applications.
