This amendment is being issued to amend and clarify certain information contained in the above-named Request for Proposals (RFP). All information contained herein is binding on all applicants who respond to this RFP. Specific parts of the RFP have been amended. The amendments are listed below; new language has been underlined and marked in bold (i.e. <u>word</u>) and language deleted has been marked with a strikeout (i.e. word). A summary of the changes is also listed below.

1. Amend RFP as follows:

Page 9, Paragraph 4: Applicants will be expected to train at least <u>200</u> 100 current or prospective cyber professionals annually during the period of performance and equip them with skills that will enhance career mobility.

To summarize, the number "100" has been replaced with "200" and the word "annually" has been deleted. Under the amendment, applicants will be expected to train at least 200 current or prospective cyber professionals during the period of performance and equip them with skills that will enhance career mobility.

The due date for proposals of **December 10, 2025 by 11:59 PM** has not been changed.
