I. Organization providing the training:

#### 2. Physical location training occurs:

Areas of West Baltimore where the Frederick Douglass Tunnel is being built. MOED's aim is for training to take place within those areas, in or near zip code 21217.

#### 3. Description of the training offered:

Job seekers are trained by providers who teach the Multi-Craft Core Curriculum (MC3) developed by North America' Building Trades Unions and administered by TradesFutures. More information about the curriculum is available here:

- First Aid, CPR, and AED

You are eligible for the program if you:

- Reside in the following zipcodes:21217, 21223, 21216, and 21201)
- Reside in the zip codes with historically high poverty rates.

## 7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment?

Individuals hired as union apprentices are eligible for progressively increasing wages that vary by apprenticeship but traditionally start around \$18 - \$22. After an apprentice attains journeyman status, wages could increase to \$30 or more per hour.
