**1. Organization providing the training:**

Mayor's Office of Employment Development (Baltimore City)

**2. Physical location training occurs:**

Areas of West Baltimore where the Frederick Douglass Tunnel is being built. MOED's aim is for training to take place within those areas, in or near zip code 21217.

**3. Description of the training offered:**

Job seekers are trained by providers who teach the Multi-Craft Core Curriculum (MC3) developed by North America's Building Trades Unions and administered by TradesFutures. More information about the curriculum is available here:

**4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:**

- MC3 Certificates
- OSHA 10
- First Aid, CPR, and AED

**5. Am I eligible?**

You are eligible for the program if you:

- Reside in the following zipcodes: 21217, 21223, 21216, and 21201)
- Reside in the zip codes with historically high poverty rates.



- Training providers may screen candidates for additional requirements related to federal jobs, including restrictions on criminal records and drug use (including cannabis r

## **7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment?**

Individuals hired as union apprentices are eligible for progressively increasing wages that vary by apprenticeship but traditionally start around \$18 - \$22. After an apprentice attains journeyman status, wages could increase to \$30 or more per hour..
