3. Description of the training offered:

The CSM IET course will provide contextualized GED and ESL instruction for adult learners, including the opportunity for participating students to have the opportunity to earn four industry-recognized credentials (OSHA-10, ATSSA Flagger, National Safety Council First Aid, and the NCCER Construction Safety Certification). Pre-Apprenticeship training will lead to apprenticeship opportunities in heavy equipment operation, roadway maintenance, and carpentry.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

- OSHA-10,
- ATSSA Flagger,
- National Safety Council First Aid,
- NCCER Construction Safety Certification.
- Pre-apprenticeship training will also lead to certifications based on employer need and input.



5. Am I eligible?

Adult Learners, those without a high school diploma, may be eligible for the College of Southern Maryland's program. Pre-apprenticeship offerings are also available to: unemployed or underemployed individuals, justice-involved individuals, individuals from economically disadvantaged backgrounds (those who live below the poverty level and are receiving SNAP, TCA, or housing assistance), women and underrepresented groups in construction and transit sectors, and veterans and military-connected individuals.

6. What is the application process?

7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment?

Participants in the program may receive wages ranging from \$16.97 to \$ 18.25 per hour.
