CEWD Skilled Trades Coordinator

Preference will be given to candidates with a college degree; experience teaching trades and/or working in multiple skilled trades fields, such as construction, electrical, HVAC, manufacturing, plumbing, metal fabrication and welding; and certified welding inspector (CWI), journeyman, master and/or other trades certifications. The days and hours of work are typically three days per week from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and two days per week from 10:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. (1 hour lunch), with evenings and weekends as needed. This is a full-time exempt position with excellent fringe benefits. The starting salary will likely range from \$60,200 to \$73,000 per year, based on qualifications and experience.
