Options for Consumers Impacted by the Bankruptcy of Voyager Digital, LLC

This advisory provides information to Maryland residents who were customers of Voyager Digital, LLC. On July 5, 2022, Voyager Digital LLC filed for Chapter 11 Bankruptcy in the Southern District of New York. Maryland consumers should be aware of the following:

Consumers may file a claim with the bankruptcy court.

Maryland consumers who had accounts with Voyager may be considered a creditor of Voyager and should consider <u>immediately</u> speaking with an attorney regarding their option to file a claim with the bankruptcy court. <u>The deadline to file a proof of claim is October 3, 2022</u>. The PDF form is available <u>here</u>, or you may submit it electronically <u>here</u>. NOTE: Submitting a proof of claim form does not guarantee that a consumer will be considered a creditor of Voyager – the bankruptcy court will make that determination.

Certain consumers may be able eligible to join the existing class action lawsuit.

On August 12, 2022, a class action lawsuit was filed against Voyager Digital, LLC in the Southern District of Florida. Maryland consumers who had accounts with Voyager and believe they may be eligible to join the class action suit should consider speaking with an attorney. If you are a member of the class, you may have already received information by mail about the lawsuit.
